

Layout artist test

Here's a portion of a script/shot list from an actual job. For the test, we only want to see these images rendered in a loose B/W (pencil type) line or color style. Draw the following script in as many frames you feel necessary to tell the story. For examples of layout styles we like, please see the following pages. Select a style you feel most comfortable completing.

An experienced layout artist will be able to draw about 15-25 loose B/W frames in an 8 hour day. If you're new to this, we like to see at least 5 frames drawn in an 8 hour period.

Hint: Use depth of field, add a variety of camera positions and forced perspective to keep the story as dynamic as possible.

Script

We open on a 40 year old mom, sitting on a couch in a living room reading a book. It's late in the evening and there is a lamp by the couch providing light.

Mom rotates her head around in a circle as if she has a stiff neck. She has one hand up rubbing the back of her neck

Her 12 year old son approaches mom from behind and begins to give her a massage. Mom is smiling in appreciation.


